


MURPHY FIELD SOFTBALL STADIUM

Fordham's new Murphy Field provides a state-of-the-art facility befitting to this Atlantic Conference Championship team. The 300-seat stadium is flanked by stone faced dug-outs. A two-story center 'block' contains restrooms and the press box in a limited existing site. Working with the existing wrought-iron gateway, the block's design frames Mr. Murphy's commemorative bronze bust with increasingly refined stonework gestures.






VIEW FROM STUDENT CENTER ENTRY

CUSTODIAL BUILDING


This extensive renovation of a commercial building provides facilities for staff members of the Custodial Department. The south-facing terra-cotta rain-screen façade fits in the existing brick-faced streetscape and deftly provides both sun-shading and security protection.





McGINLEY STUDENT CENTER

This 60,000 SF expansion of the existing 1960's Student Center nods to the neighboring Rose Hill Gym, the design re-affirms the Collegiate Gothic character of the campus at Edwards Parade Green, the heart of the university. The tower welcomes visitors to an interior multi-level arcade animated with a diversity of student life activities. These are organized, along-side the gym with a naturally-lit green wall that vitalizes even the lowest level student areas. The expansion program entails a range of collaborative work and recreational spaces that engage students and contributes to the engaged campus community.
